## LABELLING DECLARATION

At Uncle Roy's we pride ourselves in providing as much information on our products as possible for our customers in order for them to choose the correct product for their needs. In order to aid you in this, here is an explanation of product types on offer:

## **ESSENCES**

- Flavourings these are not natural
- Natural Flavourings this is the main type of natural flavours we offer. The flavouring components are 100% from natural sources but less than 95% is from the named source so are declared as "Natural Flavouring" in the Ingredients section of our labels and in the "Label Declaration" section on all Specification Sheets
- Natural x Flavourings we offer a smaller range of these flavours. The flavouring components
  are 100% from natural sources AND at least 95% from the named source. These can be
  labelled as "Natural x Flavourings" in the Ingredients section of our labels and in the "Label
  Declaration" section on all Specification Sheets, where x is the named source e.g. lemon
  would be labelled as "Natural Lemon Flavourings"
- Essential Oils these are 100% essential oils so are described as (using orange as an example):
   "Orange Oil" in the Ingredients section of our labels and in the "Label Declaration" section on all Specification Sheets.

## **COLOURS**

- Natural X Colour we offer a range of these for the Food and Drinks industry which do not
  contain any of the Southampton Six colours. Details of all Ingredients are displayed in the
  Ingredients section of our labels and in the "Label Declaration" section on all Specification
  Sheets, where X is the named source e.g. Blue would be labelled "Natural Blue Colour" and
  the ingredients would show "Spirulina Extract".
- Concentrated X Colour we offer a range of these at much lower cost as they are not Natural.
   They will contain E numbers listed on the Southampton Six. Full ingredient details will be shown on the labels in the Ingredients section and in the "Label Declaration" section on all Specification Sheets, where X is the named source e.g. Blue would be labelled as "Concentrated Blue Colour" and the ingredients would show Brilliant Blue E133
